Discarded four wheeler tyres rammed with mud were used to raise the plinth. The tyre-sides were packed with stones and mud, after which the ramming took place. This is a painfully long process, but provides a solid plinth in the end. Phew!





The structure is in paper. We used tubes that are discarded by large printers. These were joined together by PVC pipes and joints. A primer coat followed by two of bright red oil paint pare us the final elements. These form the columns and beams required.
