


# FUITE DISCLOSURE

At any rate, now that you're here, let's make a Doughnut Helmholtz Resonator together!


Before we get muddy, some fundamentals to Consider: The sound of thy doughnut is governed by the trinity of volume, Size of openings & wall thickness



## VOLUME

"larger the doughmut, lower the pitch"






## OPENINGS


"Smaller the openings, lower the pitch"






#### THICKNESS


"thicker the doughnut, lower the pitch"






With the trivity in mind, center some clay on the pollery wheel


Flatten it, and open the core all the way down




Create a channel




Raise either sides of the channel






Here's our freshly trimmed doughnut

Make a blowhole to sound the note you want (TRINITY ALERT!)




Locate toneholes as per convenience

(TRINITY!)






All toneholes done! fineture where recessary The fired doughnut will shrink a bit depending on your clay, which will rouse the pitch by a corresponding bit
